VENUE The venue of this year's Forum is the historical Helferei, where the protestant theologian Ulrich Zwingli (b/1438) worked, and from which he departed to meet his death fighting in the famous Battle of Kappel in 1551. In the heart of Zurich's Niederdorf, the Helferei adjoins the chapel to the Romanesque Grossmünster, the erstwhile monastery and according to legend built by Charlemagne. Our venue is not only steeped in history, but is easy walking distance to other historical points, shopping, dining and strolls along the Limmat and shores of the Lake of Zurich.
